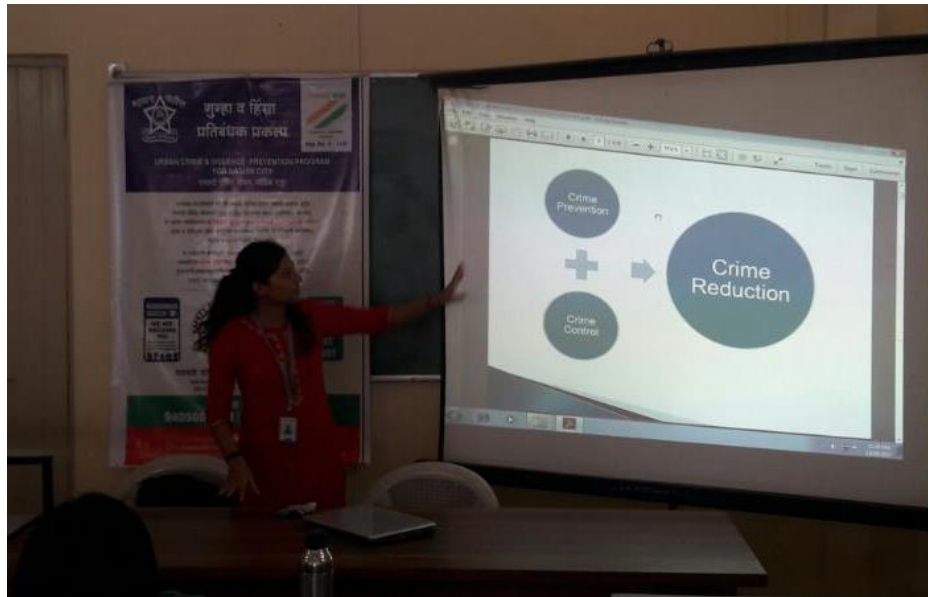
MOU Activity with Resilient India
