

A Report on international conference on “Innovations in Teaching, Learning and Evaluation in Higher Education” (ICITLE-2019) on 23rd – 24th January 2019.

Two days International Conference on “Innovations in teaching, learning and evaluation in higher education” was organized by L. V. H. Arts, Science & Commerce College, panchavati, Nashik, Maharashtra (India) (affiliated to S. P. Pune University, Pune) The conference is inaugurated and started with a welcome note by Hon’ble B. K. Deore (vice president of Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir, Nashik). He welcomed all the delegates contributing in this Conference from different corners of the globe and also briefed about the objectives of the conference and the vision of the Society. The conference is prefaced by Dr. T. B. Pawar Co-ordinator of the conference, he discussed aim of the conference, it is to explore new innovative pedagogical methods that should incorporate to meet academic needs of the students. (STKIP PGRI Bandar Lampung, Indonesia) the title of the talk was cooperative learning method in attracting heterogeneous students’ attention in reading class. She was discussed as one class usually consists of various type of students who come from different culture, religion, social and many more. These variations creating heterogeneous students. To deal with this diversity, teachers should choose an appropriate teaching method for their EFL students. Knowing this situation, the study about a method named cooperative learning method is conducted to find one of ways in helping teacher finding the best solution.
