- Conduct workshops that promote diversity and gender-sensitive communication for students and staff alike.

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


Former GS of our college **Mrs. Aarti Barve** was the key note speaker for the webinar.






# GENDER DISCRIMINATION: NEED OF SOCIAL TRANSFORMATION IN INDIA







#### Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule Jayathi Celebration





Prof. Resham Bhalla, Head, Department of Zoology and other staff members of the department along with Dr. M P Pagar, Coordinator, NSS Unit and other members took initiative for successful organization of the camp. Prof. K H Kapadnis and Prof. M. A. Bhardwaj, the vice principals of the college were invited to chair the inauguration session. Dr. Pallavi Tripathi, an Assistant Professor in Karamveer Bhausaheb Hiray Dental College, Nashik was invited as resource person.
