Introduction:

The aim of the Poetry Writing Competition is to nurture the aesthetic sense and appraise an aptitude for Literature among the students.

The topics chosen for William Wordsworth Poetry Writing Competition are relevant and appropriate. Considering the Pandemic situation, Department decided to select the Topic entitled Life for the competition. Thus, the students were encouraged to compose their poems keeping in mind the devastating impact of Corona on human life. The Department introduced the Poetry Writing Competition to fulfil the aim of the activity. Department believes that students should be exposed to the creative process thus it will help the students to appreciate the hard work a writer has to go through when he creates something new. Moreover, a writer likewise needs a platform to express his feelings hence department provides a platform for the students to exude their creative capability.

The Poetry Writing Competition is named after William Wordsworth [1770-1850], a celebrated and prolific Romantic Poet, who heralded a new movement in the English Poetry simultaneously drew the attention of the masses to the Nature and her beauty. Furthermore, his subjects were ordinary and language employed by him for the poetic composition was also very ordinary or 'rustic' in his own words. Thereof, department anticipated that his writings and contribution would instil the confidence among students to express their feelings without holding them back besides a poem can be as simple as possible because as defined by the Prophet of Nature himself "Poetry is a spontaneous overflow of powerful feelings, recollected in tranquillity".

The nature of the competition is like every year a topic is given to the students and there are supposed to write a poem on the given topic only in the classroom under the supervision of the coordinator of the programme thereafter the poems are collected from the students and evaluated and the winner is declared on 7 April, Birth Anniversary of William Wordsworth and an appreciation certificate is rewarded to the best poem.

The main objectives of William Wordsworth Poetry Writing Competition are:

- To nurture and inculcate the creative writing ability of students.
- To provide a platform for students to express their feelings.
- To expose students to the creative writing

- Taking into consideration the Corona Pandemic the competition was organized online.

- In totality 15 students submitted their poems, composing poems on various aspect of life.
