

Karmaveer Bhausaheb Hiray Birth Anniversary Programme Report 01 March 2023

Anniversary of Late Karmaveer Bhausaheb Hiray, Sculptor of United Maharashtra, Great Freedom Fighter, Father of Clan Law, was celebrated at Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir's Loknete Vyankatrao Hiray Arts, Science and Commerce College Panchavati Nashik. "Late Karmaveer Bhausaheb Hiray was a visionary leader, he was thinking ahead of time, that's why Karmaveer was an out-of-the-world leader. Late Karmaveer Bhausaheb Hiray has played a lion's share in the Economic, Social, Educational, Political, cooperative and agricultural development of Maharashtra." Stated retired Professor of Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj Shri. Ashok Sonawane. A special lecture was organized by the college to rejuvinate the activities and thoughts of Karmaveer. Speaking as the chief guest on this occasion, Prof. Mr. Sonawane said that by going against the political leaders in the then situation, Bhausaheb planted the moment of united Maharashtra with Mumbai part of it. It gave Maharashtra a separate existence. For this, Bhausaheb had to stay away from the post of Chief Minister of Maharashtra State as he took a stand against the established politicians. Going against the capitalists of that time, he implemented the historical Tribal law for the benefit of the poor farmers. A District Central Bank was established to free the common People from the trap of moneylenders and to provide loans to farmers at low rates. In the then situation, the doors of education were closed to all the common people, to bring education to the poor, Dalits and tribals of the society by establishing educational institutions like Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir and Adivasi Seva Samiti, Karmaveer spread the flood of education to the villages. Karmaveer got the inspiration of social service from the convention of Satyashodak Samaj held in 1906. And from there his social service work started. Bhausaheb along with Dhananjairao Gadgil, Vaikunthlal Mehta started Pravara Sahakari Sugar Factory, the first Cooperative Sugar Factory, in order to bring money into the hands of the farmers and thereby bring about their economic, social and educational upliftment. After this, he established Nashik Cooperative Sugar Factory and Girna Cooperative Sugar Factory for the development of the farmers of Nashik district and to give them financial stability. We were fortunate to have a leader like Late Karmaveer in our district, opined Sonawane.

On this occasion, Hon'ble Principal of the college Dr. B. S. Jagdale said that it was very important to convey the thoughts and achievements of a great personality like Karmavir to the young generation. Efforts must be made from all levels for this. He said on this occasion that the lectures of profound personalities like Sonawane should be regularly organized for the youth. Even today, Karmaver's thoughts and work- achievements are limited to one or two books in certain languages. He said that it is our duty to bring his thoughts to the
