Webinar of New Education Policy-2020

Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir's Loknete Vyankatrao Hiray Arts, Science and Commerce College, Nashik 03 has organized the Special Webinar Series on the New Education Policy. It is an initiative taken by IQAC to create awareness about the New Education Policy among the faculty and the students. The inaugural session of the series and the very first lecture was organized on 27th Aug.2022 by the Department of English. The renowned scholar of English Language, Literature and Literary Theory and the Founder of the Institute of Advanced Studies in English Dr .Ashok Thorat was the Resource Person of the first lecture of the series. His topic of deliberation was New Education Policy: Incorporating Technology in Language Studies. Prin. Dr. B .S. Jagdale presided over the function.

Dr. Thorat at the beginning of the lecture explained various features of the NEP that are the corner stones of the NEP. He called it as futuristic centric policy which is much concerned with education required in future scenario. Secondly it is first indigenous education policy that is going to set the things right from the point of view of Indian context. Earlier policies had an impact of the western education policy framed by British Govt. Thirdly it is liberal education policy with emphasis on oral tradition in education. Skill-based education, Academic Bank of Credit and multiple entry and exit are some of the facilities that make it liberal policy. Fourthly there is going to be more emphasis on multidisciplinary Research. The NRF (National Research Framework) is already in function to maintain the quality of the research.

Dr. Thorat also emphasized the role of technology in the preservation of languages. In last 40 years some of the languages have shown a fast decline. Marathi from Maharashtra is one of them. This decline has been restricted by technology. In 1976 the Government of India introduced National Informatics Centre which promoted e- governance and boost to languages. TDIL (Technology Development for Indian Languages) is the second initiative of the

Government of India which facilitated human- machine interaction without language barrier. It created human –machine interface which the help of various tools like *Anuwadak, Sampark*, Unicode, *Shivaji, Maya*. Thus languages started appearing on digital screen that made an access to the languages rather easier. Dr Thorat further stated that just as languages are being strengthen by technology in the same every aspect of human life can be supported by technology. Therefore the focus of NEP is on technology and teachers should be incorporated in technology for teaching –learning process. With the use of technology we can be closer to the human problems and technology can be absolute mediator to solve human problems.

Along with technology the other important aspect of NEP is research. Dr. Thorat belives that research should be incorporated in every sector. He referred to the undergraduate research projects being conducted in US which are multidisciplinary in nature and carried with team work. They are product –oriented and application -oriented leading to the entrepreneurship. Thus start-up culture is flourishing in US. In India we are still very much text-book oriented and classroom restricted. We need to shift to an ecosystem where there will be more focus on onthe-field experience, hands-on, skill based and technology mediated projects. Dr. Thorat also referred some of the technology based researches being pursued i.e 'Safe Internet Behavior', 'Desperate walks during Covid19' which are going to solve many human problems effectively. Thus Digital Humanities is going to play significant role in New Education Policy. The lecture was concluded by Question and Answer session.

In the presidential speech Prin. Dr .B.S Jagdale insisted on the need of outcome based education. The NEP needs teacher involvement more and more to design uniform curriculum. He also insisted on the immediate implementation of New Education Policy. The dignitaries present on the occasion were Vice Principal and the IQAC Coordinator Prof. Dr. Mrunal Bharadwaj, Vice Principal Prof. Dr. K. H. Kapadnis, Head of the Department of English Prof. Sarala Sanap, Dr.Rajani Patil (Dept.of English), Mr.Arun Thomas (Dept.of English), all Head of Department, Faculty members and students of the college. Prof.Sarala Sanap compered the program. Dr.Rajani Patil proposed the vote of thanks.




